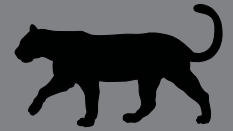


What Bugs Me?

The Adventure:

- What ideas did the other Cubs have to contribute?
- What more can you do to deal with the problems you talked about?
