Do:

- Learn to knit. Make useful items and share them with those in need.

Review:

- What do you know now that you did not know before?
- How did you feel before, during and after this Adventure?
- What problems did you encounter, and how did you overcome them?
- How did your Expedition Team work together to learn this new skill?
- What new knitting projects might you take on in the future?

Safety Note:

Some people are allergic to wool and it shrinks if not washed properly. Using acrylic or cotton yarn is a safer bet for both the knitter and the recipient of whatever's knitted.
