

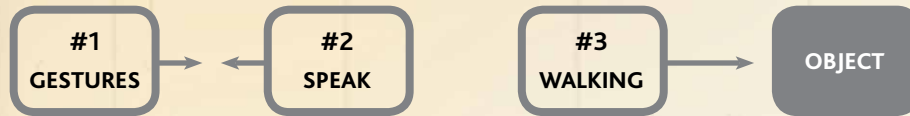

The Adventure:

Try to find something across a field with a team of three people, but each can only communicate a certain way:



Person 1 can use non-verbal communication, and is facing the playing field.

Person 2 can speak but not see what is going on (facing person 1).

Person 3 is the object finder and is walking BUT is blindfolded (cannot see).

Safety Note:

Ensure there aren't any dangerous obstacles in the path before starting the activity.

- How will you decide who will be which person of the three?
- Will you rotate who does which?
- What will be the objective in your course?
- Should you get someone else to place the object/objective so that it will be more challenging?
