The Adventure:

Play a fun game with clothespins!

Hide clothespins around your meeting hall or (better yet) in a safe play area outside. Hide more than five clothespins per Beaver Scout playing.

(You might ask your Scouters to hide the clothespins for you, to make the game even more fun!)

Every Beaver should have a clothespin to start the game. When the game starts, race around trying to pin your clothespins onto each other's shirts (or vests).

If you have a clothespin clipped on your shirt, you can take it off once you clip the clothespin in your hand onto another Beaver Scout.

If you do not have a clothespin in your hand or on your shirt, look for a hidden clothespin. When you find one, try to clip it on another Beaver.

When a Beaver has five clothespins clipped to his or her shirt, that Beaver is out of the game. Play until only three Beavers are left—they are the winners!
