



Camp Opemikon—FAQ

Where is Camp Opemikon located?

Camp Opemikon is located at 530 Hanna Road, in Maberly, ON and is approximately 20 minutes southeast of Perth.

When is Camp Opemikon open for Family Adventure Camp?

Camp Opemikon is looking forward to welcoming families beginning Friday, July 2 until Tuesday, August 31, 2021.

How much is a Day-Use pass at Camp Opemikon?

Day-Use Passes are \$22/person + HST. Day-Use Passes include access to all Camp Opemikon amenities, waterfront equipment and instructor-led programming. Children under 3 are free.

How many tent sites are available to book at Camp Opemikon?

Guests have the opportunity to choose from thirteen (13) tent campsites. All sites are non-electric and some sites have tent platforms. All sites have a picnic table, fire pit and private kybo. There are a few hike-in tent sites available, a waterfront tent site, along with one paddle-in tent site.

How many cabins are available to book at Camp Opemikon?

There are five (5) cabin options available. All have electricity and washrooms (except Venturer cabin) with some cabins more secluded and one with waterview access.

How many nights can I book at tent site?

Guests can book for a minimum of one night up to a maximum of five (5) consecutive nights. Guest may book multiple segments throughout the summer.

Can I book more than 1 week at a cabin?

Cabins cannot be booked for more than 5 consecutive nights as the property is closed on Mondays.

Are there hike-in/paddle-in camping options?

Yes. Site numbers 1, 7, 8, and 12 are hike/walk-in. Paddlers Cove site number 1 is paddle-in.

What amenities are available at Camp Opemikon?

What type of Instructor-led programming is available at Camp Opemikon?

These amenities are available to all overnight and Day-Use Pass guests.

Will washrooms and showers be available?

Public kybos (outhouses) are available during daytime operations. Every tent site and cabin is equipped with its own private kybo or washroom. Barker, Armstrong, McManus, and Carlingwood cabins all come with private showers.

Are there laundry facilities?

No. There are no laundry facilities on-site.

Can I bring my pet?

Pets are not permitted on Scouts Canada properties.

Do I need to bring my own water, or is drinking water available on site?

Drinking water is available on-site. We suggest bringing large water containers to fill-up and return to your site.

What are the check-in/out times?

Monday: CLOSED

Tuesday: Check-in 1 pm, Check-out N/A

Wednesday: Check-in 1 pm, Check-out 10 am

Thursday: Check-in 1 pm, Check-out 10 am

Friday: Check-in 1 pm, Check-out 10 am

Saturday: Check-in 1 pm, Check-out 10 am

Sunday: Check-in N/A, Check-out 10 am

Can I bring my tent-trailer/camper/RV?

Tent-trailers, campers, and RVs are not permitted on the property.

Is fishing allowed?

Yes, fishing is permitted in Christie Lake.

Can I bring my own boat/canoe/kayak?

Guests may bring their own non-motorized waterfront equipment. Electric or gas-powered boat motors are not permitted.



Is alcohol permitted?

There shall be no illegal drug/substance/cannabis or alcohol consumed on property as per Scouts Canada policy. This is a family camp model with youth on-site; as such, we have a clear obligation to care for and ensure the safety of everyone participating in our programs and activities.

Is Camp Opemikon a smoke-free property?

Yes.

Can we bring our own recreational equipment, such as boats or bikes?

Yes. Families are welcome to bring their own non-motorized watercraft, such as paddleboats, canoes, and/or kayaks. Guests are also encouraged to bring their own lifejackets when possible to minimize contact.

Canoes and lifejackets will be available on-site and sanitized after each use. This equipment is included in the Day-Use Pass cost.

Guests are also welcome to bring their own bikes and helmets to use on the property throughout their stay.
